I am a BPS Chartered and HPC Registered Child & Educational Psychologist, with **25 years experience** of working with **children and adolescents**. I have a dual qualification as a Systemic Psychotherapist registered with the UK Council of Psychotherapists.

In my current post as a Senior Clinician at Great Ormond Street Parenting and Child Service, I work within both the Child Care Consultation Team (CCCT) and the Attachment and Trauma Team (AAT). The CCCT is a national service multidisciplinary team of expert witnesses, conducting **expert assessments in Childcare Proceedings** in both Public and Private Law.

The team has speciality in **father kills mother cases**, **intergenerational sexual abuse** and in cases involving **Factitious and Induced Illness**.

The AAT is a specialist national service providing specialist expertise in the assessment and treatment of children and adolescents with a background of abuse, neglect or trauma.







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Previous to this, I worked in East London within the NHS in Child and Adolescent Mental Health Services as a Clinical Team Lead in a Conduct Disorder Team, providing assessment and treatment to children and adolescents with severe and pervasive conduct difficulties, where abuse, problematic parenting and trauma were often primary in the development of the child's needs.

I worked for several years as a senior clinician in an Adolescent Mental Health Team, with adolescents on the verge of Tier 4 admission, presenting with severe and enduring mental health difficulties. In this role, a large component of my work was assessing personality function in adolescents presenting with severe difficulties, as well as assessment of family functioning and making judgements on issues relating to child protection and mental health within the family.

I worked therapeutically with young people individually or within the family, and conduct mental health assessments. In my work on the emergency rota these assessments were during acute episodes of difficulty.

I work to support children and families to make change. I have extensive experience of working with families where there is **conflict, domestic violence and substance abuse** and in **divorce and contact disputes**. I have had considerable experience of delivering training to professionals & supervision of psychologists in training.

As a Registered Psychologist I have acquired extensive experience of psychological assessment and intervention with children throughout the age range 0-19, presenting with a wide range of different psychological needs, **Special Educational Needs and disability**.

I have specialized in working with, assessing and intervening with children with conduct disorders, emerging personality disorders, severe mental health difficulties, and also with children within the care system.

I have always worked in highly diverse areas in terms of culture, ethnicity and class,. I also have extensive experience of assessing children who do not speak English as their first language.

From 2001-2006 when working for Westminster LEA I specialized in working with children with behavioural difficulties who had been permanently excluded from school at a Pupil Referral Unit (PRU) and those within the care system. During this period I worked at the Marlborough Family Service in an Honorary role where I undertook therapeutic work with families and participated in and observed parenting assessments.

I am very experienced in report writing and in my work as an expert witness since 2008, I have written reports for the court on psychological issues of asylum and immigration, contact disputes, assessment of parenting and the assessment of the needs of looked after children, including sibling assessment.

I have provided assessments for **court of children and parents** where there are **concerns about family functioning, neglect and parenting capacity** and **assessed the psychological impact on the child**. I have assessed children and families who are **refugee and asylum seekers** and have been instrumental in highlighting their psychological needs. I have undertaken over **200 assessments within Court Proceedings, with consistent positive feedback for my work.**

I am trained in the Parent Development interview, the Dynamic Maturational Model of Attachment, the Adult Attachment Style Interview and the Story Stem Approach to assessing attachment.
