PROFILE

I am employed by the Elysium Healthcare (formerly Priory Group) as a Consultant in Forensic Psychiatry. I am registered with the General Medical Council. I am a member of the Royal College of Psychiatrists. I am approved for the purposes of Section 12(2) of the Mental Health Act 1983, as amended in 2007, and I am included as an Approved Clinician on the AC register. I have been providing psychiatric reports to criminal and civil courts since 2010 as well as for the First-Tier Tribunal Service. I also have experience of writing reports for the Parole Board as an independent expert.

SUMMARY OF CLINICAL EXPERIENCE

Since January 2014 I have been employed as a Consultant in Forensic Psychiatry at Thornford Park Hospital, Elysium Healthcare. I am responsible for 20 male patients split across two medium secure admissions wards. This involves the assessment and treatment of mentally disordered offenders via a multi-disciplinary approach involving a range of medical and psychological models. I also have a role in advising Her Majesty's Courts Service on the use of psychiatric defences in specific cases as well as being asked to give a subsequent opinion with regards to disposal.

Prior to this, I was employed as a Specialty Trainee in Forensic Psychiatry on the South London and the Maudsley Training Scheme, London Deanery. During this time, I gained experience of: medium security (male) working at the Bracton Centre; prison psychiatry working in the Kent Prison Cluster (where I also worked alongside the Consultant in a specialist ADHD clinic); high security working at Broadmoor Hospital (on both the admissions and mental illness rehabilitation wards); and medium security (female) working at the Bracton Centre. During my training, I gained experience in psychiatric court liaison and diversion with Greenwich Magistrates' Court and Bromley Magistrates' Court Schemes.
